Rose joined DVIS In November 2018 as the Vice President of Clinical Programs and Services. Rose moved into the Chief Administrative Officer position for DVIS in April 2021. Rose was the Chief Operations Officer/Interim Director at the Child Abuse Network (CAN - children's advocacy center) in Tulsa, Oklahoma from November 2017 – November 2018.
